The women who are referred here have usually come from hospitals and secure units, often having spent many years in an institutional setting. They often have complex emotional and psychological needs and require a great deal of professional support within this multi-disciplinary team.

Trauma, fear and brokenness play out in addiction and selfharm for so many of Mariposa's clients. Our staff need to be especially resilient, compassionate and good with setting clear boundaries to deliver the work that is required here.

IXION

The Ixion project is a collection of three specialist services who:

- Provide housing advice and support to Long Term Sentenced offenders in prisons in the south east of England and support them in re-integrating into the community and work to provide them with a secure home on their release.
- Provide a specialist debt and gambling support service in the West Midlands working with vulnerable clients in prison and in the community to get their debts reduced and written off and to achieve positive outcomes.
- Support clients with gambling addictions and work with them
 to achieve greater awareness of their addiction so that they can
 access specialist mainstream services.

PLEASE PRAY FOR:

- Thank God for His favour on this small team of advisors, who exceed expectations in the outcomes that they achieve for clients.
- Clients of the debt service can initially feel suicidal and desperate.
