VISION, MISSION & Values

Our vision and mission are rooted in our Christian beliefs about how God sees the world He created and Jesus' vision for humanity.

senior chaplains & senior staff

Our **senior chaplains** are both ordained Anglican priests from within the evangelical and charismatic traditions.

Our **senior staff** come from a range of denominations and free church backgrounds, many would say their faith is nurtured through personal bible reading, active church membership, regular prayer and sung worship, others would be more rooted within a liturgical or quiet tradition.

Staff with GORs (Genuine Occupational Requirements) would be expected to lead devotions and pray out loud.

Langley through its chaplaincy and senior staff seeks to invest in the spiritual health and wellbeing of all staff.

Retreats

Across Langley we meet away and overnight for business residentials and for 'retreats.' All residentials start with a bible-based devotion, a song or a hymn, and a prayer. Many of our meetings across the Trust will also begin with devotions and prayer.

Our retreats look more like a New Wine, Spring Harvest or HTB Focus (Holy Trinity Brompton) type of event than anything more 'monastic', with sung worship, bible teaching and prayer ministry, however they always incorporate compline and a communion service.

ALPHA COURSES AND WHY...

We run Alpha in all our services and one for staff online annually.

Why do we offer Alpha?

As a Christian organisation we believe everyone deserves another chance and this is exactly the stance God takes towards us all. The Christian good news is that we can all be forgiven by Jesus and restored by God's grace, furthermore we believe God's Holy Spirit can animate a person's life making them more like Jesus.

Alpha believes this too, but it is not about indoctrinating people but introducing them to the Christian faith and belief in a way which empowers them to decide for themselves if it is useful or not. We have seen people do Alpha, not become Christian but leave with a sense of forgiveness and renewal.

Our desire is that all those people with convictions that we work with would grow in hope and aspiration, that they would discover God's grace and forgiveness and go on to be the best version of themselves. Something we believe is God's desire for all people.

Alpha is a tried, tested and internationally renowned course of Christian introduction, that we offer to staff and clients alike.



MISSIONAL OUTCOMES

All our work is underpinned by prayer, and we speak of three missional outcomes we are praying for:
