MURRAY LODGE

Murray Lodge, in Coventry, provides housing, support and resettlement services for men with multiple needs, issues relating to poor mental health and substance misuse. It also provides floating support for clients living within the community.

- Give thanks for Murray Lodge volunteers, who are a breath of fresh air- spending their own time with clients talking, laughing and helping.
 They have started a weekly breakfast provision, arranged a weekly play and game day. Their work is making an invaluable difference to clients.
- Pray for good weather that enables clients to participate in outdoor activities and to help with the big plans for the gardens.
- Pray that more clients join the Alpha course and as the good news spreads more want to participate.

THE SHRUBBERY

The Shrubbery, in Kent, is a registered care home, providing a supportive environment for men with multiple and complex needs, including mental health issues, substance misuse, challenging behaviour and learning difficulties. The service provides person-centred support and one-to-one key working for everyone. Additional services are provided for clients requiring care, including physical care, psychological and mental health support. It also has large gardens and provides regular therapeutic activities. The service is well connected with local training, skills provision and community groups which help men to develop increased independence and social skills.

- Give thanks to God for growing the service, both in relation to clients and staff recruitment and for the grace of having a positive working environment.
- Pray that clients and staff would encounter God in a way they understand.
- Pray that the team would not grow weary, tired, or overwhelmed in the
 work they do and pray for fresh anointing for staff, volunteers and the
 management team for the season and challenges to come.

INFORMATION & COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (ICT TEAM)

The ICT Team maintains the technology that underpins much of the work done across Langley. This includes computers, telephones, apps, networks and other systems which all need to remain functional so that staff teams can carry out their work. With the rapid progress of technology, they must continually update systems to stay ahead of security threats.

The team respond to many service and support requests each month and aim to fix any issues they encounter as quickly as possible. When everything is working well, the work they do remains unseen and enables the organisation to operate efficiently and reliably.

- · Give thanks to God for the Christian environment the team work in.
- Pray for the team as they adapt to change.
- Pray that the team are able to take the Trust forward as their workload increases and as they learn new skills and processes.
- Pray for wisdom as some key new initiatives are implemented, aimed at supporting our people across the Trust.

DORADO

Dorado is a large service covering dispersed housing across the London area. Dorado provides housing and tenancy services for men who generally have lower support needs. However, clients who present with more entrenched support needs and who are subject to licence conditions, can also be helped. London presents its own unique challenges and our Dorado staff are skilled in working with these clients and engaging well with other local services.

PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for the spirit & support the team have shown each other during a trying time, instilling Langley's values practically.
- Pray that the team continues to progress through staffing changes. Pray for good team working conditions in Croydon, following some disruption.
- Pray that Dorado continue to improve the service they provide for clients. Pray that they can help provide clients with the skills they need to progress in life, with the Lord's guidance.
- Pray for grace for staff, as they work out how best to support clients with large rent arrears and pray for wisdom to find the most suitable resolution.

PRINCE OF PEACE

CHATTERTON HEY

Chatterton Hey is a registered care home for men with health care issues, dual diagnosis of substance misuse and mental health or a learning disability. It is set in a rural location, 6 miles from Bury town centre and 11 miles from Manchester city centre. The service provides personcentred support, one-to-one key working, physical care, medical care, psychological and mental health care and in-house social and clinical supervision for those who require this service.

PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for the slowly improving relations with the local community.
 The team are thankful for their support. Pray that these important relationships continue to improve.
- Pray for increased occupancy in the house and for the Lord to bring people who are ready to benefit from Chatterton Hey's support.
- Pray for new members of the staff team, as they are beginning to thrive.

Learning & Development Team (L&D Team)

Langley's Learning and Development Team develop and deliver the specific training all our staff and volunteers need to carry out their roles well.

 continue to do the great work that they do.
- Pray for the smooth implementation of the new Learning Management System, which will transform and improve the way that training is undertaken. Moving to e-learning will make it easier and more convenient for staff teams and the L&D Team are excited to introduce this across the Trust, over the coming months.

Kadesh

Kadesh, in Kent, offers a hostel as well as dispersed accommodation for clients who are able to live in the community with support from our staff. These clients present with a variety of needs and are usually at risk of re-offending so receiving the right level of support is really important for them. For some clients, their life skills need developing and Kadesh is an ideal place in which to learn.

- Give thanks that Kadesh have been able to take homeless men and women off the streets and provide them with a home, security and support, enabling them to make life changes.
- Kadesh is Langley's newest service, pray that Kadesh grows into a vital life-changing service within Kent.
- Pray for full occupancy and for stability within the houses and hostel and pray for the staff team to continue to work together to benefit clients.

KING OF KINGS

This month, at Langley we are thinking about Jesus Christ being King of kings. We invite the Lord to reign over everything in our lives and within Langley. We hope to see our clients and our teams making Christ King of their hearts.

- Give thanks to the King of kings for all He has done and is doing across Langley, in the lives of our clients and teams.

HMP FOSSE WAY ADVICE SERVICE

Langley Trust is contracted, by Serco, to provide specialist accommodation and debt advice to prisoners, at HMP Fosse Way. This advice is delivered in the prison, in the Resettlement Hub or on individual wings.

HMP Fosse Way is a brand-new Category C Resettlement Prison in Leicester. It is designed with provision for education, training, and jobs for prisoners on release, with the intention to cut crime and reduce reoffending. Their goal is for prisoners to learn new skills and acquire training that will provide them with viable opportunities to work when released.

PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for the great team dynamic; for the successful Alpha Course the team have been involved in; and for the many clients who have been supported with debt issues.
- Pray for more referrals for support with accommodation.
- Pray for strength for the team to bring hope and light to each other, and partners they work with. Pray for good relationships with Prison staff.
- Pray for the Lord to be with the families and victims of prisoners.
- · Pray for more clients to come to faith.

Tekoa House

Tekoa House provides housing and tenancy services for homeless men, especially those who are local to Rochdale. The service helps men to find stability and improve their situation as well as opportunities to develop skills in maintaining a tenancy. The service is staffed 24 hours a day and provides full board for its clients. With staff support, many clients are helped into suitable move-on accommodation.

- Give thanks for God's favour, with plenty of referrals.
- Give thanks for the attitude of the team and for the excellent work they do.
- Pray that more staff and clients would come to know Jesus and begin to worship Him for who He is and for all He has done.

23 September

care team

Our Care Team is responsible for securing referrals into our care homes and services, as well as working with commissioners and referrers to ensure that we understand clients' care needs and are able to meet them. The team understands the value of building trust and relationships, as there can be many months of discussion and negotiation following a client's assessment, before the package of care and costs are agreed. The Team also leads the Trust on Client Risk Management, supporting clients to make the changes needed to live offence free lives.

- Give thanks for the way that the Shrubbery's reputation, as a provider
 of excellent care, is already spreading, leading to a good number of
 referrals for new clients who might benefit from that provision.
- Pray that the team will be able to present the excellent work of Langley, and secure further the current Ministry of Justice contract for supporting clients on probation.
- Pray that the team can move forward the Enabling Environment programme, which will help staff and clients to work and live in an environment where all can live the best versions of themselves.

30 SEPTEMBER

THE KNOLE

The Knole is a registered care home, in Cheltenham, for men who have offended or are at risk of offending and who have multiple needs, including mental health needs or a learning disability. The staff are deeply committed to delivering excellent care to clients with quite complex needs, and teamwork is a particularly strong feature at this service.

PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for the Team of amazing staff who work at the Knole and the way that they create opportunities for residents to develop and grow.
- Give thanks for the Chaplain, Graham and the sacrificial way that he supports them.
- Pray that the Knole will be full and give the people they support the best opportunity for a bright future.
- Pray for more spiritual growth and maturity in the residents at the Knole and for fresh ways to engage them in conversations regarding hope and faith.

JUSTICE

HOUSE OF ST. MARTIN

House of St. Martin (HSM) is a registered care home for men who have offended or are at risk of offending, and who present with multiple needs, including substance misuse, mental health needs or a learning disability. It is located three miles from Taunton and is particularly suitable for those with mobility issues

PRAYER TOPICS

- · Give thanks for a full team of staff at HSM.
- Give thanks and celebrate the life of the HSM client who died, this year.
- Pray for clients who move on from HSM, that they would successfully settle in the community. Pray especially for a client who recently moved on from HSM, that he would be happy in his new home.
- Pray for a previous client that he would find peace and support within the community.

HUMAN RESOURCES TEAM (HR TEAM)
