# 06 JULY

## LANGLEY THEME – GOD IS LOVE

Over the next few months, we will be considering some aspects of who God is. This month we begin with 'God is... love'. God's love is unconditional and different to any other love we can experience. Our hope is that every client, staff member and volunteer would accept the love of God.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for the Lord's unconditional love towards us and each client, staff member and volunteer.
- Many of our clients have experienced trauma, sometimes at the hands of those who were said to 'love' them. Pray that the Lord would bring healing and that they would experience the genuine love of God.
- Pray that each client, staff member and volunteer would have opportunity to hear and receive the love of God towards them, while they are with Langley.

# 13 JULY

## LANGDON HOUSE

Langdon House is an Independent Approved Premises, which has been newly refurbished and offers 17 beds. Located in Poole within a peaceful residential area next to a park, it offers a welcoming and well-situated environment for residents with easy access to the local town and services.

The staff team are all new to Langley, with most starting in March. Langdon opened in April and is in a ramp up process, gaining residents each week.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks that Langdon has been able to open and has begun to operate, as planned.
- Pray that the Lord would bolster and sustain the staff team, to ensure consistent operational resilience and effectiveness
- Pray that the Holy Spirit would dwell at Langdon, revealing His peace and great love to everyone who passes by or enters the premises (whether resident, staff, or visitor).

# 20 JULY

## DORADO

Dorado is a large service covering dispersed housing across the London area. Dorado provides housing and tenancy services for men who generally have lower support needs. However, clients who present with more entrenched support needs and who are subject to licence conditions, can also be helped. London presents its own unique challenges and our Dorado staff are skilled in working with these clients and engaging well with other local services.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for the Lord's grace in giving the Dorado team love and consideration for those less fortunate.
- Pray for opportunities to show kindness, be a positive influence, and help those in need around them.
- Pray that the hand of the Lord is seen in the work of Dorado.

# 27 JULY

## MURRAY LODGE

Murray Lodge is a supported living service for men, in Coventry, providing housing, support and resettlement services for men with multiple needs, issues relating to poor mental health and substance misuse. It also provides floating support for clients living within the community.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for the new members of staff. Pray that they would be embedded in the Langley values and remain with the service for a long time.
- Pray for the mental health of clients.
- Pray for clients' resilience not to return to their past lives.

# 03 AUGUST

## LANGLEY THEME – GOD IS GOOD

This month our Langley theme is 'God is... good'. God is innately perfect and holy. He always does what is right and His plans for us are always good. Our hope is that every client, staff member and volunteer would experience the goodness of God in their lives.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Thank God for His goodness and for His good plans towards each of us.
- Many of our clients have experienced people whose intentions towards them have been harmful, rather than good. Pray for healing from past hurts and hearts that are open to receiving the goodness and the good plans of God.
- Pray that each client, staff member and volunteer would experience something of the goodness of God through their time with Langley.

# 10 AUGUST

## BRADFORD SUPPORTED HOUSING

Bradford Supported Housing Service provides housing and support for men with low to medium level support needs, substance misuse and mental health needs across Bradford and the outlying suburbs ranging from 1 bed properties to 11. The team work with local churches and agencies to develop social and tenancy readiness skills to support the clients back into fully independent living.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for the recent new properties and for the opportunity to work with double the number of clients.
- Pray for the appointment of the right service manager.
- Pray for bonding of a new team.

# 17 AUGUST

## THE KNOLE

The Knole is a registered care home in Cheltenham for men who have offended or are at risk of offending and who have multiple needs, including mental health needs or a learning disability. The staff are deeply committed to delivering excellent care to clients with quite complex needs, and teamwork is a particularly strong feature at this service.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for a full team of amazing staff, doing some amazing work.
- Pray to find more ways of helping the people that the Knole support to hear, receive and believe the good news of Jesus.
- Pray for older residents to remain well and comfortable during their final years.

# 24 AUGUST

## PEOPLE SERVICES (H.R.) TEAM

Our People Services (H.R.) Team is responsible for supporting our volunteers, staff and managers from before they join us, through to the end of their time with Langley. They are usually the first point of contact with candidates to Langley (first impressions count!) and engage with new starters as they prepare to join their teams. Business Partners play a vital role for everyone who works or volunteers at Langley - partnering with services to provide support, expert advice on employment law and compliance Policies and Procedures.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for the dedication and heart of every member of the People Team, serving with compassion and integrity.
- Pray that every person at Langley experiences sustainable well-being: spiritually, emotionally, and physically, and that the People Team would have wisdom to create healthy rhythms for all.
- Pray for leadership, processes and culture, that fairness, grace, and transparency would mark our culture and every people-related process, from recruitment to reviews to conflict resolution.

# 31 AUGUST

## HOUSE OF ST. MARTIN (HSM)

House of St. Martin (HSM) is a registered care home for men who have offended or are at risk of offending, and who present with multiple needs, including substance misuse, mental health needs or a learning disability. It is located three miles from Taunton and is particularly suitable for those with mobility issues.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Thank God for the peace that dwells in the house. It is evident that the Holy Spirit is present. With so many differing needs among the client group, it is a place of safety and somewhere clients can call home, amid so much uncertainty.
- Pray that the team would feel equipped and enabled to meet client need, through delivery of care and support.
- Pray that referrals for clients would increase and that HSM can offer a place of safety and meet people's needs.

# 07 SEPTEMBER

## LANGLEY THEME – GOD IS IN CONTROL

# 14 SEPTEMBER

## BOX TREE COTTAGE

Box Tree Cottage is an Independent Approved Premises (IAP), in Bradford, housing men on their release from prison. Referrals and allocations to Box Tree Cottage are made by Probation Central Referrals Unit.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Thank God that residents find Box Tree Cottage to be an enabling and supportive environment and sanctuary for many, where staff are unified in wanting to provide them the best care and opportunities.
- Pray for the staff team to be channels of God's transforming power, with His compassion and wisdom giving the drive and insight to assist residents in making positive changes. Pray for the team as they work with complex and high-risk individuals, that they receive God's guidance and power to provide effective interventions.
- Pray for safety for all residents, staff members and volunteers - that the team are equipped with foresight to manage risk, and psychological resilience to remain a steady presence for residents.

# 21 SEPTEMBER

## LANGLEY LEADERSHIP RETREAT

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for a fully staffed team, including two new chaplains.
- Pray for strength and courage for several clients facing physical health issues.
- Pray for positive move-ons for clients who have been with Park View for a long time.

# 05 OCTOBER

## GOD IS RESTORING

This month's Langley theme is 'God is... restoring'. ## PRISONS WEEK

# 19 OCTOBER

## LANGLEY CHAPLAINS

Each of our services is supported by chaplains, whose role is to support the spiritual health of a local service, encouraging and sharing Jesus' love, amongst clients and staff. They also act as ambassadors for Langley, helping to build strong relationships between Langley and local churches. Many of our Langley Chaplains are volunteers.

## PRAYER TOPICS

# 26 OCTOBER

## CHATTERTON HEY

Chatterton Hey is a registered care home for men with health care issues, dual diagnosis of substance misuse and mental health or a learning disability. It is set in a rural location, 6 miles from Bury town centre and 11 miles from Manchester city centre. The service provides person-centred support, one-to-one key working, physical care, medical care, psychological and mental health care and in-house social and clinical supervision for those who require this service.

## PRAYER TOPICS

- Give thanks for professional friends and partners of Chatterton Hey, who play an active role in enabling them to support clients to achieve positive results.
- Pray that the Lord gives wisdom to make effective decisions as Chatterton Hey continue to recruit new members to the staff team.
- Pray that clients continue to recover and thrive and that Chatterton Hey can make effective use of the capacity within the service.
